Find peaceful, scenic and even rugged stretches of river with abundant bird and wildlife viewing.

Hike, run or bike along the river at *Explore Park* or on the *Roanoke River Greenway,* which runs parallel to the blueway for nearly 20 miles.

Within the City of Roanoke, the blueway takes on an urban character as it winds through neighborhoods, parks and the outskirts of downtown. This means that residents and visitors have easy access to the river, and paddlers have easy access to parking, dining, supplies and refreshments.

Ways to experience the Roanoke River Blueway



Canoes, kayaks, tubes and even stand-up paddleboards are all great ways to enjoy the river. Some stretches are ideal for beginners and families with children, while other portions include challenging white water rapids. Always check river levels before going on the river.



There are great fishing opportunities on the **Roanoke River Blueway.** Smallmouth and largemouth bass, bluegill, catfish and trout are among the species found in the river. Portions of the river are part of Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries' trout stocking program.



Enjoy the beauty and serenity of the **Roanoke River Blueway** as it flows alongside nearly 45 miles of the *Roanoke River* Greenway, a paved multi-use trail for walking, jogging or biking. More trail access to the river exists at *Explore Park* just off the *Blue Ridge Parkway* in Roanoke County.
